Gro Trondalen, PhD, MA-MT, Fellow of AMI, is Professor in Music Therapy and Senior researcher at the Centre for Research in Music and Health (CREMAH) at the Norwegian Academy of Music. She is an experienced music therapy clinician and supervisor in the field of child welfare and adult mental health and maintains a private practice in The Bonny Method of Guided Imagery and Music (GIM).

The title of the lecture is “Collaboration and Exchange in Music: an intersubjective perspective”

Professor Trondalen will be introduced by Professor Helen Odell-Miller OBE, Director of the Cambridge Institute for Music Therapy Research at Anglia Ruskin University, and Vice Chair of The Music Therapy Charity. The lecture falls in the 50th anniversary year of The Music Therapy Charity, and celebrates the long established work of the charity in supporting music therapy research.
